

TOWN OF SLUNJ AMONG THE MOST HOSPITABLE WORLD DESTINATIONS



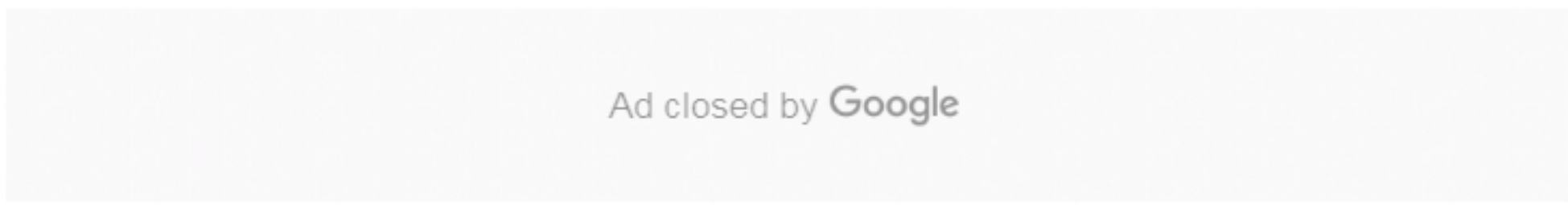
